With lung damage left by COVID-19, CT Women in the Wind (WITW) member “Kitt” is working diligently with doctors and physical therapists just to breathe and live normally again. Her life now depends on having oxygen 24/7 and she’s working hard to regain her strength and stamina. When Kitt told fellow WITW friend, Gosia from her hospital bed that her only goal is just “to ride again,” Gosia immediately sprang into action.

A talented lampwork artist at Flame Licked Designs, Gosia created dozens of original jewelry pieces for a private online auction using 100% of the proceeds to fund a portable oxygen concentrator Kitt can strap to her Harley’s passenger seat so she can breathe while riding. News of the auction spread throughout the motorcycling community, donations came pouring in from WITW members and beyond, and Gosia’s donated works brought in almost three times the original goal! When Kitt found out about the outpouring of love and support, she was speechless. The motorcycle community is simply amazing, offering an army of strength and inspiration—we *will* help Kitt, and others like her, to ride again.
