Hello friends! This newsletter is our way of sharing articles and news recently posted on WomenRidersNow.com (WRN).

One of the coolest things about the motorcycle community is how charitable riders are. I recently had an amazing experience involving bikes and fundraising. I rode my BMW to Vermont to join Liz Campbell's "Moto Cavalry" which supports the Kelly Brush Foundation (KBF) bicycle ride. KBF helps people living with spinal cord injuries live active, healthy lives. Many of the participants ride adaptive bicycles using only their upper body to pedal over the 20-, 50-, or 100-mile scenic (and hilly) routes!



The Motos (that's what the Cavalry calls its professional network of motorcyclists) are connected through several different apps and tech gadgets and ride our motorcycles spaced out along the routes, slowly passing the bicyclists and circling back again and again. We carry things like spare tire tubes, pumps, tools, candy, and other emergency supplies. If there's an issue that we can't fix on the spot, we alert Liz and help arrives within minutes.

Dressed in hi-viz vests and gear, the Motos offer more than just physical support. Riding alongside riders who are breathing heavily, offering big air fist bumps and shouts like, "Yes! You got this!" is always greeted with a big smile. Sometimes encouragement is all that's needed to make it to the next peak.

The number of bicyclists who went out of their way to thank us and tell us how important our

presence was to them elevated the day to be one of my top riding experiences. Sometimes pedaling alone for hours, having a Moto ride by with a "thumbs up" offered the reassurance they were still on-course. By the way, the KBR brought in \$1.2 million which will help so many others get out there and enjoy life to its fullest.



Tour Spain & Portugal with Women Riders Now



Bill Kniegge may be a less-than-familiar name but one we'd love to introduce you to. Bill was heavily involved in the <u>tour of Italy WRN</u> staff and readers attended back in 2015. WRN will be partnering up once again with Bill and his tour company, <u>Blue Strada Tours</u> to offer a "Ladies First" Tour of Portugal and Western Spain September 27–October 4, 2024.

Details are still being worked out, but the tour will offer at least six days of riding with several female motorcycle industry leaders, 4-star hospitality and food, and a support vehicle that will transport luggage and souveniers. BMW, Honda, and Royal Enfield standard and ADV motorcycles are available from 500cc to 1250cc. This tour is open to women and those who accompany a woman. Prices will start at about \$5,000 (not including airfare) and there will be limited participation.
