I just returned from Ohio's <u>American Motorcyclist Association's (AMA) Hall of Fame Days</u> where, among other activities, I met women Hall of Famers while rubbing elbows with some of motorcycling's greatest legends. The weekend was filled with riding, bike nights, a "Motorcycle Mary" film screening, racing, and important industry meetings. Women motorcyclists were represented in all these areas.



Some of my favorite legends and leaders in attendance included: Rita Coombs (HOF 2023), a leading voice in motorcycle racing; Mary McGee (HOF 2019), all-around superstar; Delvene Manning, owner of Bonneville Motorcycle Speed Trials; BJ Hessler, founder/owner of DC Dirt Camp; Karen Umphress, off-highway advocacy and management expert; Cyndi Brandt, long-time promoter of the Mid-Atlantic Women Motorcycle Rally (MAWMR); and WRN's Sarah Schilke. The incredible Debbie Matthews was inducted into the Hall of Fame for her lifetime of racing and promoting women's motocross.

To top it off, a future female legend made history. Six-year-old Sofia Huffman of Team Sophia MX took 1st place in the very first AMA Pit Bike Hare Scrambles, racing the boys. Her hero Debbie Matthews took notice and spent some time with the youngster. You go girls!


